- <u>Security Team Message</u>: Please call Security in advance of guests, contractors, vendors or other service providers coming into National for deliveries, visits or work. This will assist you and the Security Staff in getting these visitors through the security gates quickly and efficiently. Call: 910-295-4381.
- <u>ARB Note</u>: The ARB will begin sending out a quarterly news message on construction and other ARB matters. Updates to the current ARB Guidelines are in the works and will be sent to all residents via Constant Contact once completed as well as being posted to the NPOA Website.
- **Fox & Wildlife Update**: The Wildlife Professionals that were hired to take out the foxes from National have completed their work. No additional rabid foxes were reported and there have been less sightings of foxes recently. The professionals did remove several raccoons & possums. They have been called back to our community recently to catch a coyote that has been roaming National. During the monitoring for the coyote, a fox was just caught and removed from the National, along with two raccoons. We will keep you posted on the outcome with regard to the coyote.
- **Drainage Work**: Drainage work continues in National. Two drainage projects have been completed one on National Drive and one in Ballybunion Park. Currently, Butler Constructs is working on the drainage basin and ditch on Royal Dublin Drive. Once that project is completed, they will move over to Leven Links to work on a drainage project there.
- <u>A Special Note to National Residents</u>: The comfort stations on the golf course are for human use only. Housekeepers have observed residents and their dogs utilizing the comfort stations on the golf course – both throwing away pet refuse and allowing pets to drink from the toilet. The toilets contain chemicals that mix with the water to help keep the toilets clean and are not safe for pets to drink. Often times, the stations are left quite dirty and smelly after a pet's visit.
