2023 Board completed initiatives

- 1. Dungarvan/Greencastle drainage issues mostly solved with improvements to curbing; larger scale plans discontinued
- 2. Yard waste rule changes lead to improved aesthetics around the neighborhood
- 3. New fence and landscaping give back gate a fresh and more attractive look, thanks largely to Gardeners-on-the-Go Committee (Laurie Griffin, Jo Cooper, Judy Vanica, Janice Ellstrom)
- 4. New paving puts finishing touches on Ballybunion Park area after surge of new construction wraps up
- 5. New exit gate at Security House serves to finally close-in the entire perimeter and enhance neighborhood security
- 6. Security camera with audio recording installed at front gate guest entrance to better document NPOA employee interactions with visitors
- 7. Security House porch floor leveled to improve safety for NPOA employee work environment
- 8. Two John Deere landscape vehicles (Gators) acquired to replace aging units leased through Pinehurst Resort & Country Club
- 9. Security House roof replacement renews life expectancy of roof structure and improves front gate appeal
- 10. 2024 Board expansion to 11 members creates opportunity for sharing workloads and improved Officer and Director transitions from year to year
- 11. Modernization of NPOA Board, ARB and staff communications and document archiving with Microsoft Office 365 Business Suite (Outlook, Teams and OneDrive)

Future/ongoing Board initiatives

- 1. Work together with Pinehurst Resort & Country Club to update current agreement between parties related to shared interests in the neighborhood
- 2. Continue working on vision for future development and use of condominiums in Sections 10-A & 10-B (condos around the pool and tennis courts)
- 3. Monitor Sandstone Rehabilitation Facility commercial development adjacent to neighborhood and support concerns related to potential impacts to NPOA Member residents
